

Tom Reed Campaign Donations: Q1-Q3 2017¹

Executive Summary

In the first 9 months of 2017, Tom Reed raised \$1,385,746. 54.58% (or \$756,400) was donated by Political Action Committees (PACs). Of this amount, \$674,850 was donated by businesses, \$37,500 by labor, and the remaining labeled as Ideological.

Of the PAC donations, the largest donation was from the Insurance Sector at \$105,655. Next, the Securities and Investment Sector PACs donated a total of \$82,600, followed by the Beer, Wine and Liquor Sector at \$75,775. Health Professionals and Pharmaceutical Health Products PACs donated a total of \$79,150. Examples of the individual companies donating to Reed include: Corning, Inc, \$32,555, NextEra Energy, \$25,000, Council of Insurance Agents and Brokers \$10,000, and Metlife, Inc, \$10,000.

\$617,397 (or 44.55%) were donated by individuals. Of the monies donations by individuals, only \$38,301 was donated by people in small quantities (\$200 or less). The remaining \$579,096 was donated by large donors giving more than than \$200. Approximately 2.75% of his donations were from small donors giving less than \$200, while over 50% of his donations were from Political Action Committees.
