

Donations Accepted by Reed in 2017¹

Executive Summary

Tom Reed accepted donations totaling approximately \$1,754,851 in 2017. \$976,686 was accepted from 377 political action committees (PACs), representing 55.6% of his total. \$773,165 was raised through individual donations. His overall fundraising totals for 2017 were more than double the House average of \$863,240.

366 of the 377 PACs Reed accepted donations from were located outside of the 23rd Congressional District. In total, 99.97% of donated PAC money came from outside of the District. The 11 PAC donations accepted from inside the 23rd totaled only \$11,275, or 0.012% of the total.

Out-of-state donors contributed more than 47% of the individual donation funds Reed received in 2017. Out-of-district donors gave more than 81%, or \$606,597, of his individual donation funds. Donors from the greater Washington DC Metro Area donated \$94,823, or 12% of his total individual donations. Donors from in-state metropolitan areas outside of the 23rd Congressional District gave 33%, or \$256,214, of his in-state individual donations.

Large individual donations (over \$200) comprised \$729,984, or 94.4% of the individual donated funds he accepted. Reed accepted only 2.4% of his 2017 totals, or \$43,181, in small contributions (under \$200).
